At 1.15pm on Tuesday 23rd June 2006, Humber Coastguard received a report of yet another vehicle which had attempted to cross Holy Island Causeway, outside of the clearly displayed safe crossing times. Two males had abandoned their water logged vehicle, and had made their way to the Refuge Box. Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat was requested to launch, and the two males were taken by lifeboat to the shore and handed to the care of Seahouses Coastguards, who had also been dispatched to the incident. They were also suitably advised.
