### **COLLAPSED MALE BROUGHT TO SAFETY BY LIFEBOAT**

At **12.15pm** on **Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2006**, Humber Coastguard received the report of a man having collapsed on rocks at the water's edge opposite the Lifeboat Station, at Seahouses. An ambulance had been called, but the tide was rising where the man was collapsed, and he was at risk. The Station Mechanic was also made aware of the incident by harbour staff, and it was agreed to launch the Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat without further delay. Meanwhile an Ambulance First Responder had arrived and was treating the casualty, who had regained consciousness. The man, who was 30yrs of age, and from the Felling area, was camping at North Sunderland. He was brought to Seahouses Harbour in the Inshore Lifeboat, and taken to the Lifeboat Station to await the ambulance. The casualty had recovered considerably by arrival of the ambulance, and after examination by the paramedic, he declined to attend hospital.
