At **10.30pm**, on **Saturday 24th July, 2004**, Humber Coastguard requested the launch of both Seahouses Lifeboats, after receiving a report of an inflatable dinghy drifting out to sea off Newton Haven. Craster Inshore Lifeboat was also launched. A full search of the area was carried out and nothing found. It is believed that it was a yacht tender returning a yacht moored in the haven. The incident was recorded as a false alarm, with good intent. All three lifeboats then returned to station.
