At **3.12pm**, on **Thursday 21st April, 2005**, Humber Coastguard requested the immediate launch of the Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat, following a request for assistance from ***the North East Ambulance Service***. One of their vehicles was trying to reach an emergency call on Holy Island, and the causeway was flooded. High water was 1.52pm, and the causeway was still well covered. The Lifeboat launched but before it could reach the causeway, Ambulance Control reported that their vehicle had managed to wade safely across the causeway. Humber Coastguard cancelled the Lifeboat, which then returned to station. The RNLI have no information about the casualty or their condition.
