At **3.23pm**, on **Saturday 21st August, 2004**, Humber Coastguard received a "999" call reporting an adult and two children, in difficulty in the riptide off Bamburgh beach. Local Coastguards were alerted and Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat was requested to launch immediately.

As the Lifeboat cleared the harbour, the Coastguard received further information that the casualties were safely ashore, which was confirmed by shore Coastguard units. The Lifeboat was cancelled and returned to station. No further details of the casualties are known by the RNLI.
