FISHING CHARTER BOAT REQUEST ASSISTANCE AFTER MEMBER OF FISHING PARTY COLLAPSES

At 12.40pm on Saturday 13th August, 2005, just after completing their last incident with a critically injured diver, Seahouses Lifeboat Crew and Coastguards were called into action again, when the Seahouses Charter Vessel "**Bright Horizon**", reported one of the fishing party aboard the vessel had collapsed on deck, and requested urgent medical assistance. The Lifeboat Crew responded with local coastguards, and treated the casualty on arrival at Seahouses harbour, until the arrival of an ambulance still on the harbour from the last incident. A doctor also attended. The casualty, a male in his fifties from the Wiltshire area, was put aboard the ambulance and taken to hospital for treatment. He was suspected to have possibly suffered a heart attack, but had regained consciousness sufficiently to converse with emergency services teams on scene.
