At **9.51pm** on **Friday 31st August 2007**, Humber Coastguard received that a **“MAYDAY”** distress call from a fishing vessel with one person on board, which reported hitting rocks near Seahouses Harbour. The vessel was in danger of taking water, and requested urgent assistance. It was decided to launch both Seahouses Lifeboats immediately, and the casualty was located to the south of the harbour. A pump was transferred, and the vessel was pulled clear of the rocks, and escorted into Seahouses Harbour, where it was beached onto the slipway, so it could be inspected for damage. Once the skipper and his vessel were safe at Seahouses, both lifeboats returned to station.
