At 4.10pm on **Bank Holiday Monday 29th August, 2005**, Seahouses RNLI All Weather Lifeboat was engaged in activities relating to their Annual Lifeboat Fete, when Humber Coastguard requested their immediate assistance for the second time that afternoon. An inflatable dinghy with two girls aboard was being blown out to sea in Embleton Bay. Craster Inshore Lifeboat had also been launched and reached the scene before the Seahouses Lifeboat. They dealt with the incident, and Seahouses Lifeboat was cancelled, and was able to return to the Fete at Seahouses Harbour.
