At 1.46pm on **Saturday 8th September 2007**, Humber Coastguard received a report of several persons in a motor vehicle, stranded on Holy Island Causeway, attempting to cross outside of the safe crossing times. Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat was requested to launch, and on reaching the scene, it was established that the occupants were not in immediate danger, and that they were happy to remain with their car until the tide dropped. The Inshore Lifeboat then returned to station.

High water at Seahouses was 1.48pm.

Safe Crossing Times were from 3.30am to 11.50am and from 4.25pm to midnight.
