Details: At 10.42 pm, on Monday 8th November, 2004, Humber Coastguard requested the Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat to assemble and stand by, following reports of a female threatening self harm at Seahouses Harbour. Local Coastguards had already been alerted, and were on the harbour. The Lifeboat launched and was about to conduct a search of the harbour area, when it was stood down by Humber Coastguard, following confirmation that the woman had been located safe and well at her home by the police.
