At **9.37am** on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2007**, Humber Coastguard paged the Seahouses Lifeboat Launch Authority, and advised him that they were in receipt of a "999" call from a dog owner, reporting that her dog had gone into the sea off Bamburgh beach, and was at risk of being washed out to sea. It was agreed to launch Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat, which quickly located the dog off the Islestone Rocks. The dog was taken back to the safety of the shore, and returned to a grateful owner.

The Lifeboat then returned to station.
