At **4.50pm** on **Saturday 27th May 2006**, Humber Coastguard received multiple "999" calls reporting a 6 metre yacht having capsized off Holy Island, with three persons in the water requiring urgent assistance. Seahouses All Weather Lifeboat RNLB "Grace Darling" was requested to launch immediately, and on reaching the scene, it was established that the 3 persons from the yacht had been picked up by another vessel, and landed safely at Holy island. One was suffering from hypothermia, and had a heart condition, so he was airifted by RAF Helicopter to Wansbeck Hospital for treatment, while the capsized yacht "Quintain" was recovered by the lifeboat, and taken into the harbour at Holy Island.

Attached Photos show the capsized yacht and the crew dealing with the emergency, and finally with the yacht in tow but with the mast now snapped.
