At 9.19pm on Tuesday 6th June 2006, Humber Coastguard received a radio call from the 17 metre fishing trawler "Bright Ray", which had engine problems 19 miles off Seahouses at the Farn Deeps, requesting assistance. An oil pipe had fractured, and the vessel was unable to reach Seahouses under its own power. Seahouses Lifeboat was requested to launch, and reached the casualty at 10.16pm. A tow line was passed, and the vessel, which had three crew on board, was towed to Seahouses, arriving at 12.10am, so that repairs could be effected.
