At **4.49pm** on **Sunday 19th June, 2005**, Humber Coastguard requested the assistance of the Seahouses All Weather and Inshore Lifeboats, in the search for a missing 8yr old female child, last seen near the waters edge east of Bamburgh Castle. Both Lifeboats launched, and additional crew members made their way to the scene in the station Landrover to assist on foot. The child was found safe and well on the mainland and the Lifeboats were recalled, returning at 5.45pm.
