INSHORE LIFEBOAT CALLED TO HOLY ISLAND CAUSEWAY.

At **7.16am** on **Saturday 26th July 2008**, Humber Coastguard requested Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat to launch to the Holy Island Causeway, where a car with three occupants was trapped by the rising tide. The occupants were making their way to the Refuge Box. Due to the coastal fog, the Inshore Lifeboat was taken by road. On reaching the Causeway, the Lifeboat was stood down, as local Coastguards from Holy Island had rescued the casualties. Their vehicle was apparently stuck in sand at the causeway, prompting speculation that it may have driven off the actual roadway. The lifeboat then returned to station.
