### **BROKEN DOWN RIGID INFLATABLE BOAT AND LOST SOMEWHERE OFF SEAHOUSES**

At 12:42hr on **Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2010**, **Humber Coastguard** paged the duty launch authority, and requested the launch of **Seahouses Lifeboat**, to go to the assistance of the Rigid Inflatable Boat "**Horizon**" with three persons onboard, with three persons onboard had lost all power and was unsure of his position. It was believed to be somewhere east of Seahouses. It was agreed to launch the All Weather Lifeboat, and once underway the lifeboat located the casualty some seven miles east of the lifeboat station using Direction Finding equipment. A towline was passed and the casualty vessel was towed to Beadnell Harbour, where it was met by Local Coastguards.

The Lifeboat was then released to return to station.
