BROKEN DOWN ANGLING BOAT IN BEADNELL BAY

At **19.50hr** on **Friday 12th September 2008**, Humber Coastguard paged the duty Deputy Launch Authority, reporting that a 20' angling boat was broken down in Beadnell Bay, and requested assistance. The boat was in danger of being blown ashore. It was decided to launch both Lifeboats, but as the boats reached the slipway, Humber coastguard reported that the casualty had managed to restart their engine. The launch was halted, but the crews remained in immediate readiness, until the vessel and crew were safely ashore. Once this was confirmed, the lifeboats were re-housed.
