CAR AND TWO OCCUPANTS STRANDED ON HOLY ISLAND CAUSEWAY

At **14.50hr** on **Sunday 14th September 2008**, Humber Coastguard paged the duty Deputy Launch Authority, reporting that a car and two occupants were stranded by the rising tide on Holy Island Causeway. The Inshore Lifeboat Crew were paged, and the ILB launched. The Lifeboat was part way to the scene, when it was cancelled by the coastguard, as the two persons had managed to wade safely ashore, abandoning their vehicle on the causeway. The Lifeboat returned to station.
