### **BOAT TAKING WATER IN SEAHOUSES HARBOUR**

At **7.33 am** on **Saturday 15th October, 2008**, the owner of passenger vessel "Glad Tidings IV" contacted the Lifeboat Operations Manager, requesting assistance as the vessel had been found by her crew, taking water in Seahouses Harbour. The Lifeboat Crew were paged and the salvage pump from the All Weather Lifeboat was taken to the flooded vessel by the station Landrover. It was put aboard the vessel which was pumped dry, so that the owners could investigate the leak. No persons were aboard the vessel at the time, and non one was in any danger.
