At **13.56hr** on **Friday 27th August, 2010**, Humber Coastguard requested the launch of Seahouses All Weather Lifeboat, to go to the assistance of a Dive RIB (Rigid Inflatable Boat) "**BOBCAT**", with 4 persons on board which had broken down off Longstone Island. The All Weather Lifeboat Crew were paged, and the Lifeboat proceeded to the casualty. On arrival, it was found that a local vessel "Farne Diver" had taken the vessel in tow. The vessels were then escorted by the lifeboat but once it was obvious that they were in no danger, the Lifeboat returned to station.
