At **16.30hr** on **Friday 27th August**, **2010**, Humber Coastguard requested the launch of Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat, to go to the assistance of six youngsters reported swimming in the sea off Beadnell Point. As the youngsters were some distance off the shore, the caller reporting the incident, was concerned that they may be in difficulty. On arrival at the scene, the youngsters were located by local Coastgard Recue Officers on the shore, safe and well. The incident was a False Alarm with Good Intent, made probably with recent more tragic incidents in mind on this coast involving swimmers. The Lifeboat then retuned to station.
