CAPSIZED KAYAK, PERSONS STRUGGLING IN THE WATER

At **14.49hr** on **Saturday 18th September 2010**, Humber Coastguard requested the launch of Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat, to go to the assistance of two persons from a capsized kayak, reported struggling in the water off Beadnell Harbour The Inshore Lifeboat was quickly launched and the two persons quickly located and were pulled from the water. Their kayak was also recovered, and all were taken to the shore through the surf, where they were safely landed. Neither canoeist required medical assistance. The canoeists were believed to be from the Widdrington area, and were handed into the care of local Coastguard Rescue Personnel on the shore. The Inshore Lifeboat was then released and returned to station.
