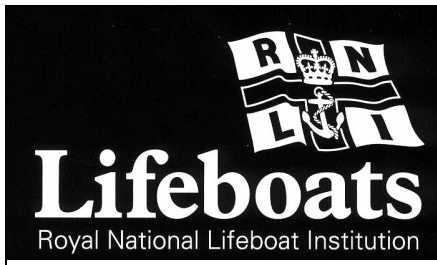

False alarm - Good Intent.

At 4.16pm on Saturday 7th August, 1999, Tyne Tees Coastguard received a report from a concerned member of the public, that a small inflatable with two persons on board, may be in difficulties off Monk's House, between Bamburgh and Seahouses. Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat was requested to launch and investigate. On arrival, it was found that the persons on this boat had been fishing, and did not require any assistance.

Although a false alarm, the coastguards were more than satisfied that the call had been made with good intent.
