At 11.00am on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2007, Northumbria Police requested assistance to convey two police officers to Inner Farne, where the wardens had discovered possible human remains while renovating a footpath on the island. The Deputy Launch Authority agreed to the request, and the crew were called non-urgently, and launched at 11.40am. On completion of the officers' examination of the scene, they were returned to Seahouses, and the Lifeboat returned to station. The remains are believed to possibly be very old, and the police are continuing their enquiries. This is a Police enquiry and the RNLI have no further information.
