At **9.54am**, on **Thursday 2nd June, 2005**, Humber Coastguard requested the immediate launch of the Seahouses RNLI Inshore Lifeboat, after receiving an emergency mobile phone call from a party of 6 walkers on the old Pilgrims Way Holy Island Crossing. They had been up to their waist in the rising tide, and were concerned for their safety. A rescue Helicopter from RAF Boulmer was also scrambled. The Helicopter reached the scene just before the Lifeboat, and the persons were uplifted to safety on Holy Island. Once it was confirmed that all were safe and accounted for, the Lifeboat returned to station. The RNLI have no details of the casualties.
