TWO YOUTHS STRANDED ON SEAHOUSES SOUTH BREAKWATER / ROCKS.

Location: Breakwater and rocks, south side of Seahouses Harbour.

Crew: Inshore Lifeboat: Stuart Patterson, Gary Annison, Eric Stanwix.

Launchers: John Hanvey, Martin Malone.

Details: Humber Coastguard received a call from the police, stating that an officer had seen two youngsters on the rocks on the south side of the harbour, and that she was concerned that they had been cut off by the tide. High water was 4.41pm (Spring Tide - a high tide)

Humber coastguard requested immediate launch of the Seahouses Inshore Lifeboat, to check the area as the youths were now no longer in sight. The area was searched, and a Coastguard patrol established from members of the public that the youths had safely come ashore. After the area was checked by the Inshore Lifeboat and by Coastguards, the Lifeboat returned to station. The identity of the youths is not known at this time, but they are believed to be quite young.
